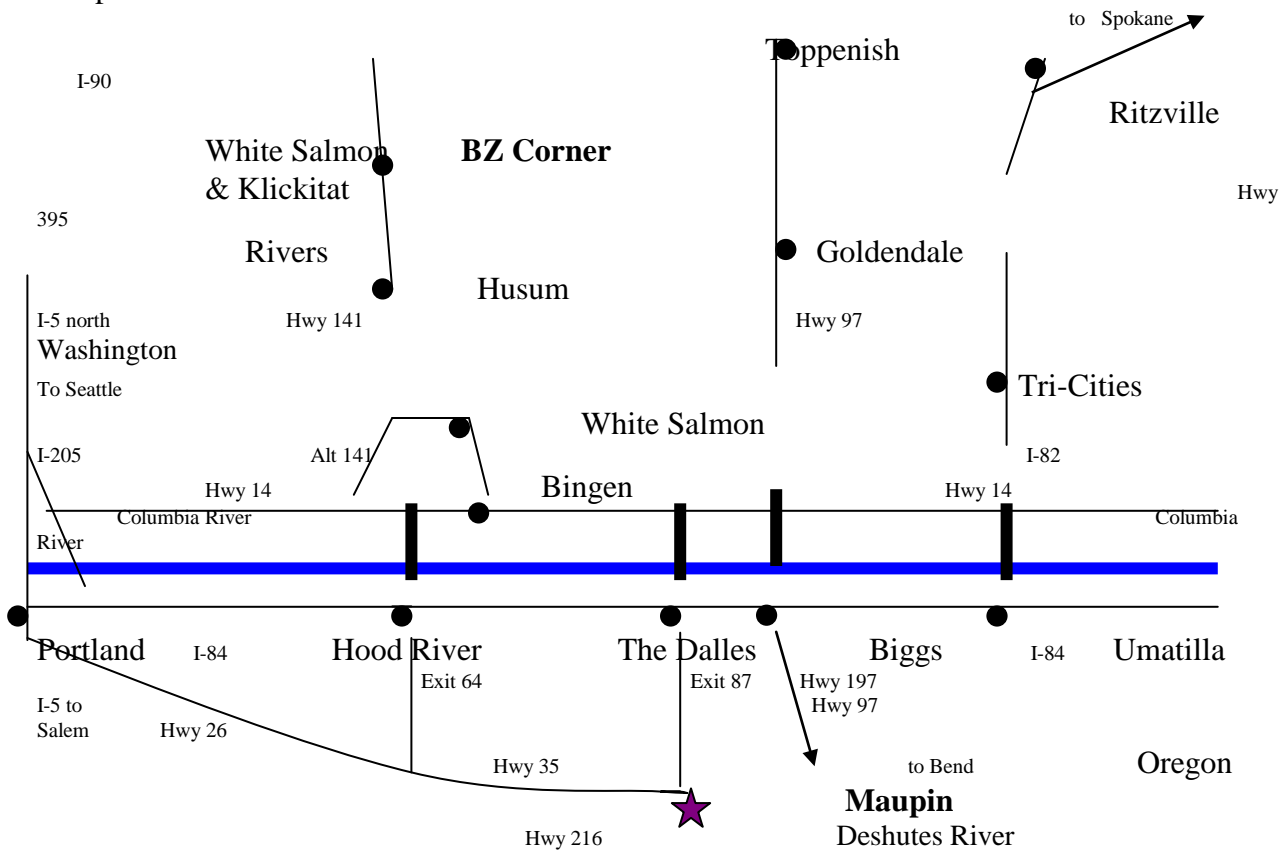

From the Seattle area, take I-5 south to Portland, Oregon. Take I-205 south to I-84 east to The Dalles, Oregon. Turn south on 197 from The Dalles to Maupin, Oregon approximately 40 miles.

From Spokane area, take 90 west. In Ritzville, take 395 south to the Tri-Cities.

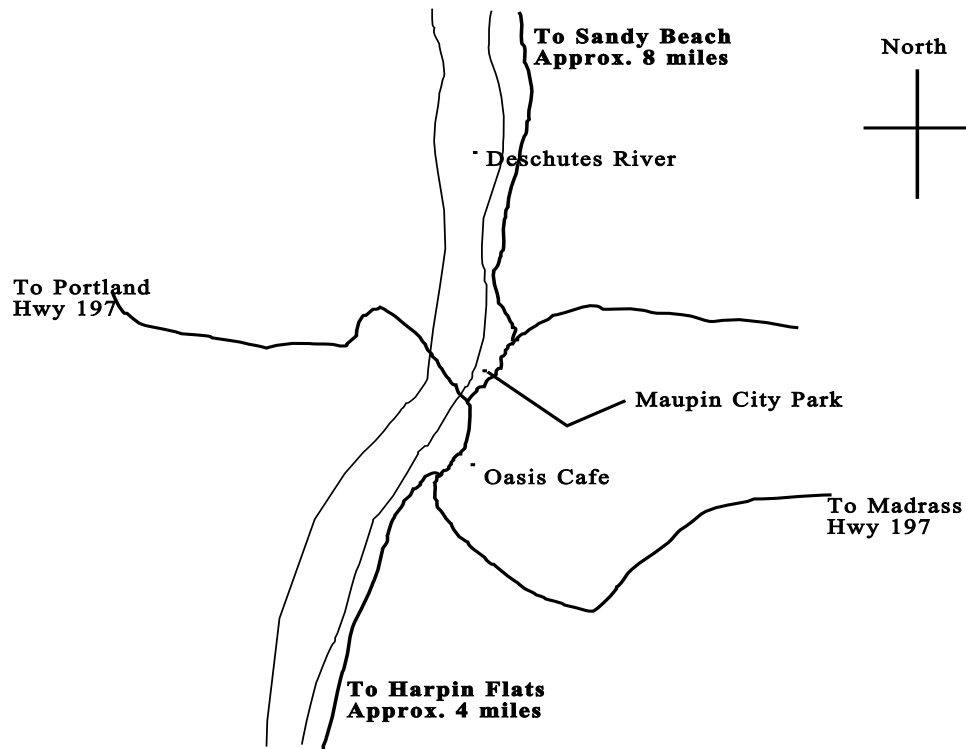
From the Tri-Cities area stay on hwy. 395 south until it connects with 82 south. Then take Hwy. 14 west to Dallesport and then hwy.197 south to The Dalles or take 84 west to The Dalles. Either way, in The Dalles take hwy.197 south to the town of Maupin.

From Eugene / Salem area, take I-5 north to 205 north. Exit onto 26 East and then 216 East to Maupin.

Maupin Area

Directions to Sandy Beach. Just after you cross the bridge over the Deschutes River in Maupin, take a hard left on the road that follows the river. Just past **Maupin Park** take a left on the road that parallels the river heading north. In approximately 8 miles you will see the Sandy Beach take out. There should be plenty of parking here. Be here by 10:00am

What to wear:

Your river trip includes guides, rafts, paddles, shuttles and a life jacket. We can bring splash jackets and booties if you request them. Bathing suits can be worn if it is a nice hot day and/or shorts. No cotton or denim. We suggest bringing water guns for water fighting and a towel for changing later. Also, if you need to wear glasses on the river it is a good idea to have glasses holders. We will have glasses retainers for sale riverside if you forget yours. A hat with a string attached is also a good idea. See you there!
